Greenway from Knoxville to the Smokies

Imagine riding on a bicycle trail from Alcoa or Maryville to downtown Knoxville. Or to Townsend and the edge of the Great Smoky Mountains National Park.

Now do more than imagine it. Join us in creating a 45-mile greenway from Knoxville to the Smokies. Check out the Vision Map to see where this greenway could take you.

In Progress

A greenway from Marine Park in Knoxville to Singleton Station Road in the City of Alcoa is already planned, and TDOT will be constructing much of it as part of the widening of Alcoa Highway. From there, the greenway will connect to the existing network of greenways in Alcoa and Maryville. Part of it was recently completed, and the rest is fully funded.

Completing the Vision

We're working with local governments on funding to complete the link between Maryville and Townsend. The plan calls for the greenway to run along the U.S. 321 right of way. Several segments are already fully or partially funded.
